Now, I want to address something that has happened this past month that affects each one of us in a deep and emotional way.



It may not be hatred to the extreme that cause this tragedy, but it is still hatred towards others. When we carry this animosity and hate towards others, it poisons our souls. We must rid ourselves of these negative feelings towards others. Each person in our world and community has a special light and purpose within them. It may be hard to see another person's light, but that doesn't mean that it is not there. You never know the effect someone has on another. We all have silent struggles in our lives, but it is our responsibility not to add to the suffering of others. A smile, a kind gesture, a thoughtful word, may well change the course of a person's destiny. If we can only believe that love heals, then the world would be healed.
